

## National Assembly adopts four new draft laws.



(KPL) The National Assembly (NA) has agreed on adopting eight draft laws yesterday in the 8th current session of the 6th National Assembly, under the chairmanship of NA President Thongsing Thammavong. The eight draft laws have been approved following nine days in sessions.

NA President Thongsing Thammavong said that the eight laws saw it meet the social demand and would contribute to assist the current socio-economic development plan. The adopted laws include the new bills on tobacco control, youth affairs, construction, public investment, and the amended draft laws on people's court, public prosecutor organization, and document registration renamed from notary public. NA members have seriously debated on each draft law. These include youth and tobacco control, since some articles were not clear enough. These laws are hoped to serve as new legal tool for regulating society and maintaining social orderliness.
