

## Draft Law on Lao Public Prosecutor's Organization proposed.



(Kpl-E23.11.09.06) Mr. Somphanh Phengkhammy, President of the Lao Public Prosecutor's Organization, yesterday put forth the amended draft law on Lao Public Prosecutor's Organization to the 8th Ordinary Session of the National Assembly's Sixth Legislature. The amendment to the draft law was attributed to the necessity to make it comply to the current realities and the district and municipality public prosecutor's organizations will be changed into the regional public prosecutor's organizations, said Mr. Somphanh. He said that the amendment would improve its content and make it simple to understand for further enforcement. In addition, the NA's members brainstormed on the draft law to make it more detailed and short. Mr. Somphanh said one of the main objectives of the amendment was to leave out part three of the law concerning the decision on the grant of pardon to prisoners. This role and duties belong to the Supreme Public Prosecutor's Organization. The current law on the Public Prosecutor's Organization includes seven parts, eight charters and 55 articles. The amended draft law will have eight parts, nine charters and 67 articles.
