

Lawmakers define draft law on statistics.



(KPL) Lawmakers of the sixth National Assembly debated a draft law on statistics at the 9th Ordinary Session of the assembly yesterday.

Vice-Presidents of the National Assembly, Ms. Pany Yathortou, and Mr. Saysomphone Phomvihane co-chaired the session.

Introducing the draft law to the meeting, Minister of Planning and Investment, Mr. Sinlavong Khoudphaythoune, said that the aim of the law was to set rules, disciplines and measures for the implementation and administration, monitoring as well as inspection of the statistic work to make this work area systematic and strengthen for the socio-economic development of the country.
